GET STARTED

This past weekend, Northside Multiplied was introduced, and we were asked if we would join the mission to become a “multiplier.” This might be a scary question, but worth asking in this context. **What would it look like if you multiplied yourself? Stated another way, if everyone in the world were more like you, would the world be better or worse? Have fun, but be honest with yourself when discussing this with your group.**

What encouraged and/or challenged you from the message this week?

TALK IT OVER

- When we hear the word “multiply,” many of us think about “more,” but, in your mind, does more mean better? Consider these questions:
 - **Is there truth to the saying that “more is not always better”?**
 - **What are some of the things of this world that would make you think more is not always better?**
 - **Are there any spiritual things that would fall into the category of more not always being better?**
 - **Can we be too spiritual? Too godly? Too heavenly minded?**
- In addition to increasing in number, another definition of the word “multiply” is to “make or become greater.” **In what way can we, as individuals or as a church, become “greater”?**

Read Genesis 1:26-31

- God tells Adam and Eve to “be fruitful and multiply.” **What does the world “multiply” mean in this context? Do you feel it is only in reference to childbearing, or were there other ways in which Adam and Eve were to multiply? Do any or all of those ways Adam and Eve were told to multiply still apply to us today?**
- Genesis chapter 1 is the Creation story. Verse 27 says that God created mankind in His own image. **What does this statement mean to you?**

Read Matthew 28:16-20

This portion of Scripture is called “The Great Commission” and gives us insight into God’s vision for His church. Many of you have read this passage or heard it preached multiple times, while

others may have heard it now for the first time. **No matter your experience with the message of The Great Commission, how would you describe it to someone who has never heard it before?**

Read Acts 9:31

Here we see two things that will help the church multiply—walking in the fear of the Lord and walking in the comfort of the Holy Spirit. **Discuss what both of these phrases mean with your group:**

- **Walking in the fear of the Lord**
- **Walking in the comfort of the Holy Spirit**
