### INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- As a child, were you usually picked for teams first, middle, or last? Do you think that experience affected how you approach the world today?
- Have you ever been invited into the inner circle of someone you admired? What was that experience like?

### KEY PASSAGES:

- **1 Corinthians 12:13** - How revolutionary do you think this type of social structure in the Church was in the time and culture this was written?
- **Colossians 3:11** - What are some of the modern dividing lines people tend to put up in the Church?
- **Matthew 9:10-13** - Do you think people would get an accurate picture of who's invited to Jesus' inner circle by looking at your life and the people who spend time with you? Why or why not?

### GROUP DISCUSSION:

- Have you ever felt as if Jesus wouldn't want to be around you? What changed?
- In general, do you think Christians often spend time with the same kind of people Jesus welcomed into His life?
- How can we both pursue holiness and also maintain relationships with people who are far from God? How have you tried to strike that balance?
- Tell us about the last meaningful conversation you had with someone who isn't a Jesus follower.
- Who do you know who needs to be invited into your inner circle so they can get a better glimpse of Jesus? How can you reach out to them this week?
